Medical Transportation ~

Medical transportation to and from appointments is an amenity offered by Emerald Bay. Residents may schedule up to two trips per month—anything more than that needs special approval from Tabatha, our Executive Director. Transportation is scheduled on a first-come-first-served basis. The more advanced notice you give the driver, the better chance you have at getting on his schedule. Last minute appointments are not guaranteed. As a rule, PLEASE CONFIRM all upcoming appointments with Doug, our driver, at least two weeks prior to your appointment. His hours are Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. If he is not in the building, please call him and leave a message and he will return your call as soon as he can to confirm your appointment. You can reach Doug at (920) 471-5441. Please do not contact him after hours or on the weekends. You may also give your appointment information to Nurse Sarah, or an RA, who will then pass it on to Doug. Also, please remember that your designated family member (the person that is allowed to come in to your room) can now take you to your appointments. If your designated family member takes you on an appointment, we ask that you do not go anywhere else other than to and from your appointment, that everyone wears a mask, and that you change your clothes as soon as you return. 
